



Decide how you are going to use your shoe party to fundraise for myshoes. here is a list of tips and ideas to get you started:

charging entrance

You could ask your friends to donate £5+ for coming to the Shoe Party at your house. If you are holding your Shoe Party at a bar or restaurant, make sure your invitation clearly states what is included in the ticket price and that there is a good margin of profit for you to donate.

Donating shoes

Ask your friends to bring their hardly worn designer shoes to be auctioned in the MyShoes eBay Shop. You know, the ones that hurt their feet and they no longer wear. Take them all home with you and put in a box and call DHL on 0207 371 6644 to arrange a collection.

Drink promotions

If you are holding your Shoe Party in a Bar, would the owners be interested in creating a Shoe Cocktail especially for the night? Maybe they could donate all the profits from that Shoe Cocktail to your fundraising?

Food

Make a MyShoes cake (download our guides) and ask your guests to pay £1+ a slice.

Many local businesses will happily donate goods or services to be raffled.

You could try your local shoe shop and ask for a gift token for a Prize Draw, your local beauty salon for a pedicure gift token, your local chemist for some 'feet-treats' of foot moisturisers or even ask a local jewellery shop for a donation of toe-rings or ankle bracelets.

Remember that it is usually easier to successfully ask for donations in small independent shops that you shop in regularly as they will be keen to support the local community. (Chain-stores often require you to write to their head office which can take a long time).

Just a note of a caution, please do not sell raffle tickets in advance of the night of the party as this contravenes certain licenses.
